



DMCAR Leads Re-Negotiation of Building Performance Standards

Our effort takes aim, while our like-organization colleagues at NAIOP, the Colorado Apartment Association and the Colorado Hotels and Lodging Association combine efforts to put in place a federal lawsuit aimed at injunction.

In late June, [the Supreme Court took down Chevron Deference](#), a move that reduces power of federal agencies to interpret the laws – in particular as it relates to environmental law. Courts will now interpret ambiguous laws. The landmark decision had been in place since 1984.
